LPG Changeover and Categories course is for experienced operatives who already hold either Core Domestic Natural Gas Safety (CCN1) or Core Commercial Gas Safety (COCN1) and wish to work on LPG fired appliances in permanent dwellings and other premise types.

- Operatives who hold either the Core Domestic Natural Gas Safety (CCN1) or Core Commercial Gas Safety (COCN1). Also operatives must hold the domestic natural gas qualification for LPG appliance types that they wish to work on.
